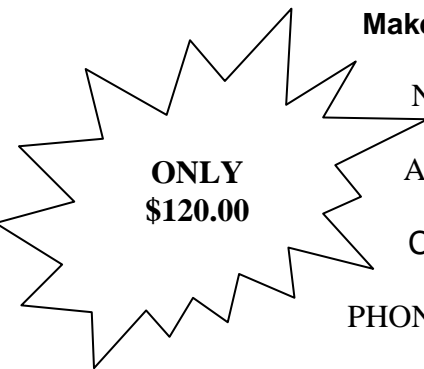

CAMP OHIO is located in Licking County Ohio, approximately 1 hour North East of Columbus, and 8 miles from Utica, Ohio on County Road 210 in Eden Township near the center of Ohio. The nature trails winding through the rolling forest of Camp Ohio offers some of the most tranquil and serene areas in Central Ohio. The accommodations are rustic although the convenience of hot showers, modern plumbing, and hot food are available. Telephone, television, radios and lawns to mow aren't available. **HONEY DO LISTS PROHIBITED**

SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS are part of our "Back To Basics" theme. Although rustic, each heated dormitory will accommodate up to 15 men. Each bunk is equipped with a foam mattress, but you must supply your own towels, toilet articles and bedroll or sleeping bag.

THE NIGHTS AND MORNINGS are cool/cold so make sure a jacket or sweater is part of your planned clothing. We have planned a roaring fire each morning and each evening. That will help take the chill off, but find the true warmth with the fellowship and the Three Legacies offered during the weekend.

A FULL WEEKEND of speakers, meeting and workshops are planned. However, should you prefer some quiet time to work on yourself, talk with you sponsor, write a fourth step or just enjoy the tranquility of the surroundings, you are free to do so. A small catch and release pond is on the property for the anglers, golf is approximately 20 minutes away and the nature trails are available anytime. It is your weekend and your time; take it to do as **YOU** wish. No one is expected to attend the meetings or workshop unless they want to. So please sign up now and be a part of the Buckeye men's Rendezvous.
